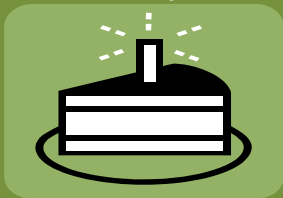
Dec Gift Exchange
